STEP 1: Download & print your entry form from May 1st, at EBSFT Facebook or eastboldre.org or

collect from Chapel Stores. Complete & return to Chapel Stores with £5 (cash only) by June 1st 5pm.

STEP 2: Construct your 3D Scarecrow design and display it in your garden from 22nd - 29th June.

This year's theme is 'East Boldre Village'. Ensure your scarecrow is safely away from all animals.

STEP 3: Join the fun on the 28th-29th June. A trail map and quiz will be available Saturday and

Sunday for £2 from The Turfcutters pub, Chapel Stores and East Boldre school fields.

Prize categories include Best Dressed, Scariest, Most "Village-y," Most Creative, Overall Winner, and 'The Kevin House' award. Just like Eurovision, follow the judge's voting progress with Phil Hart's Scarecrow leaderboard on Sunday afternoon at the hall.

Competition Rules

- 1. The competition to design, build and display a scarecrow on the theme of "East Boldre Village" is open to anyone living in the Village of East Boldre.
- 2. The fee for a household/business/organisation is £5 and multiple scarecrows can be made.
- 3. Visitor trail maps (with quiz) will list the numbers of all the scarecrows on the trail. Please bring a pen/pencil to complete the quiz.
- 4. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
- 5. Nearer the start date you will be supplied with a number card to display by or on your scarecrow. This will correspond with the numbers on the visitor trail maps purchased over the weekend.
- 6. Each scarecrow and its number card must be positioned so it can be viewed by the public from the road/pavement.
- 7. Scarecrows must be appropriately secured so as not to blow away or to pose any risk of injury or damage to any person, animal or property. The organisers cannot take any responsibility for damage caused by the creation, erection or display of any scarecrow.
- 8. Scarecrows must be of 3D construction. Beyond this requirement, entrants are free to build their scarecrow as they see fit and using whatever materials they wish.
- 9. This is a family-friendly event. The organisers reserve discretion to disqualify any entry regarded as obscene or as having been designed to cause deliberate offence.
- **10.** Submission of a completed entry form and payment of the entry fee(s) is deemed as acceptance of these rules.
