



East Boldre Baptist Chapel - Burial Register Analysis

The Burial Register Excel spreadsheet produced from the burial register held at Hampshire Records Office in Winchester allows us to analyse the burial register data for East Boldre's Baptist church members between 1837 and 1894.

The graph below shows the total number of burials each year in blue. The trendline indicates that generally the number of burials on the chapel site decreased over the 57 year period.



The second graph looks at the split between burials of adults and children. The linear trendlines show that while adult burial remained fairly constant over this time the number of burials of children decreased significantly as infant mortality was addressed.



Clear peaks can be seen in the graphs, some possibly indicating particular epidemics. Scarlet Fever which disproportionately affects children under 10 recurs on a roughly 5 year cycle. The data possibly indicate when these epidemics occurred.

All deaths were registered by a coroner/registrars. Several offices served East Boldre with most deaths being registered with the Lymington coroner.
